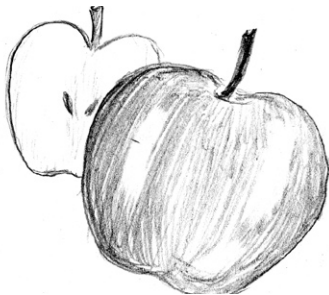




October 22, 2005

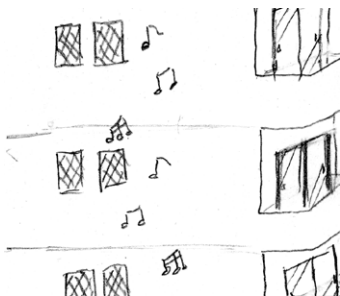




October 26, 2005

BUILDING UNDER CONSTRUCTION

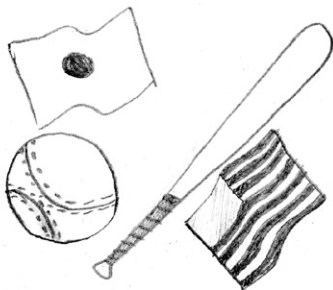
